

Math Analysis Grading Policy and Classroom Expectations

Course Description: Students will strengthen and expand on skills from topics learned in Algebra II, brief introduction to basic trigonometry and some basic calculus concepts. This course will help prepare students for college level mathematics courses.

Text: A Graphical Approach to Precalculus with Limits: A Unit Circle Approach, ISBN-13:978-0-13-136992-4

Recommended Supplies: Three-ring binder with dividers, loose-leaf paper, graph paper, pencils, erasers, highlighter/colored pens, scientific calculator or graphing calculator

Grading Procedure: Grades are determined as follows:

Homework/Classwork: Homework is assigned every day (with few exceptions) and is due at the beginning of the following class period (unless otherwise stated). If a student has not done their homework they may come in during the next Eagle Time to make up the assignment without penalty, otherwise their grade for that assignment will be a zero. If a student has an excused absence, the student is responsible for completing his/her homework/classwork assignments. **Any assignments that are missing will result in a zero.**

Quizzes/Tests: Quizzes may or may not be announced while tests will always be announced. Quizzes and tests may be focused on current topics being covered in class, or cumulative.

*If a student is legally absent on a quiz or a test day, students are expected to make up the missed quiz/test the day they return. If a student is out for more than one day an appointment must be made with me to make up the test/quiz. **Failure to make up a missed quiz/test before the end of the quarter will result in a zero.**

* If a student is absent on a review day before a quiz/test and no new material has been taught during that missed day, **the student will be required to take the quiz/test on the originally scheduled day.**

No Name Papers: It is important that students always put their name on their paper. If there is not a name on the assignment then no credit will be given for the assignment.
